SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The SandHills Stock Show & Rodeo will award at least Seven \$1000 scholarships to the most qualified horse, lamb, steer, heifer and goat exhibitors. To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must comply with the following guidelines:

- (1) Be an active member of the FFA or 4-H program and be exhibiting in the current livestock show. Should an applicant not show in the current SandHills Stock Show, his/her application would be void.
- (2) The applicant must be a senior in high school when making application and also must have been in the top 50% of the class the previous year (junior year).
- (3) The most qualified applicants from the steer, heifer, lamb, horse and goat divisions will be considered for the seven \$1000 scholarships.
- (4) The applicant must turn in a complete application by December 1.
- (5) Submit with application a 500 word or less essay describing the applicant's activities, including the kind of projects and scope of each, leadership and citizenship activities, interest in attending college and future plans.
- (6) Be able to attend an interview with the scholarship committee during the SandHills Stock Show & Rodeo. Applicants will be notified if interviews are necessary.
- (7) Scholarship funds will be sent to the financial aide officer of the recipients chosen accredited college or university after entrance verification. The funds are to reimburse the college for the student's tuition and fees in the amount not to exceed the total specified sum of each award.
- (8) Scholarship winners must attend college the fall semester after graduation
- (9) Scholarship winners will be selected based on:
 - A. Scholastic achievement
 - B. School and Community activities
 - C. Financial need
